WHAT IS UXO?

Unexploded ordnance (UXO) is explosive munitions that were prepared for action but did not activate. Most UXO is from past activities associated with military troop training or weapons system testing. If UXO detonates, it could cause serious injury or death.


You may encounter UXO at the Limestone Hills Training Area.

How UXO Appears in the Environment?

UXO may not be visible. It can be on the surface and obscured by vegetation, partially buried, or completely buried.

Most UXO is located within the first two feet of the surface, but may be found at depths up to 20 feet or imbedded in trees.

UXO may appear in pieces. All UXO, whether intact or in parts, presents a potential hazard.




What Does UXO Look Like?

UXO comes in all shapes and sizes – from small bullets to large bombs. However, its shape may be altered by impact or partial detonation. Types and lengths of UXO that may be found at the Limestone Hills are shown on the left-hand column of this page.

UXO Safety Procedures The Three R's

Recognize


UXO becomes a danger only when it is disturbed. When you see UXO, STOP.

Retreat

Do not move closer to get a better look! Never attempt to remove anything near it. Do not touch, move, or disturb. MOVE AWAY.

Report

Immediately report any suspected UXO to your supervisor.
